## Waste Management Plan

## **Calculations for How Many Bins Required and Emptying**

- In general, expect a minimum of one litre of waste per person per meal.
- As an example: 500 people x (1 mealtimes + 1 snack/drink) = 1000 litres of estimated waste. Divide 1000 by 240 litres (a standard bin) = 4 bins = 4 bin stations of 2 waste and 2 recycling bin each. This is minimum requirement.
- The cleaner will be clearing tables and picking up discarded rubbish, directed by the Market Manager.

## Waste Management Strategies to be Implemented for proposed market

- Cambridge Market policy states it is mandatory for stallholders to remove all their own rubbish and take with them when they leave site.
- This will be monitored by the Market Manager and Cleaner.
- Stall holders to avoid packaging as per Northern Beaches guidelines
- Stallholders to provide reusable or recyclable items for food and beverages.
- Cambridge Markets will provide highly visible, clearly labelled waste and recycling bins.
- Bins to be emptied before they are full.
- Stallholders to store used wastewater in a sealed container and remove for off-site disposal.
- Wastewater is not permitted to be disposed of via the stormwater drain.
- Bins will be arranged consistently throughout the site, with a recycling bin always next to a waste bin.
- Bins are located to where food and beverages will be consumed, at entry/exit points, close to toilets/facilities and at the intersection of pathways.
- Refer bin collection point and bin transfer routes to the collection point.
- Market cleaner to monitor bins use and to encourage appropriate bin use.
- There are bins positioned at the end of each row for easy access. refer to site map attached
- Contamination management to ensure waste is sorted into the correct bins to be undertaken by the Market Cleaner.
- The event will have predominantly offsite food preparation.
- Mealtimes covered by the event will be breakfast and lunch.
- The market will utilise the existing waste service provider engaged by the HBC.
- Waste will be removed off site as per their existing arrangements.
- Bins will be wheeled from their positions to club garbage collection point.
- Market Cleaner to patrol the market continually to ensure waste is disposed of appropriately.
- Market Manager is responsible for complete review of the site once market has enclosed to ensure all bins, and waste has been removed as per instructions and guidelines.
