Reasons for referral

This application seeks consent for the following:

- new residential works with three or more dwellings. (RFB's, townhouses, seniors living, guesthouses, etc). or
- mixed use developments containing three or more residential dwellings. or
- new subdivisions of three or more lots. (Private road and public road subdivisions) or

And as such, Councils Waste Management Officers are required to consider the likely impacts on drainage regimes.

Officer comments

Waste Management Assessment - amended plans (submitted 2/4/2024)
Supported - subject to conditions

Waste Management Assessment
Unsupported.

Specifically:

There is no area dedicated for the storage of garbage and recycling bins on the plans.

The words "bin area" appears at several different locations on the plans. It is unclear what this actually means as the words are in different locations on different plans (e.g. in the middle of the driveway).

A dedicated bin storage area must be provided and clearly shown on the plans along with demonstrated access for a HR truck to the bin storage area.

The proposal is therefore supported.

CONDITIONS TO BE SATISFIED PRIOR TO THE ISSUE OF THE CONSTRUCTION CERTIFICATE

Waste and Recycling Requirements

Details demonstrating compliance with Northern Beaches Waste Management Guidelines, are to be submitted to and approved by the Certifier prior to the issue of any Construction Certificate.

If the proposal, when compliant with the Northern Beaches Waste Management Guidelines, causes inconsistencies with other parts of the approval i.e. architectural or landscaped plans, a modification(s) to the development may be required.

Reason: To ensure adequate and appropriate waste and recycling facilities are provided.

CONDITIONS TO BE COMPLIED WITH DURING DEMOLITION AND BUILDING WORK

Waste/Recycling Requirements (Waste Plan Submitted)

During demolition and/or construction the proposal/works shall be generally consistent with the submitted Waste Management Plan (version 2) prepared by Environmental Earth Sciences dated 4/5/2023.

Reason: To ensure waste is minimised and adequate and appropriate waste and recycling facilities are provided.

Waste/Recycling Requirements (Materials)

During demolition and/or construction the following materials are to be separated for recycling: timber, bricks, tiles, plasterboard, metal, concrete, and evidence of disposal for recycling is to be retained on site.

Reason: To ensure waste is minimised and recovered for recycling where possible.

CONDITIONS WHICH MUST BE COMPLIED WITH PRIOR TO THE ISSUE OF THE OCCUPATION CERTIFICATE

Waste/Recycling Compliance Documentation

Evidence of disposal for recycling from the construction/demolition works shall be submitted to the Principal Certifier prior to the issue of an Occupation Certificate.

Reason: To ensure waste is minimised and recycled.
