Construction is currently very noisy and dusty causing adverse impacts on our family life. We have young children (5 year old twins) whose bedroom is exposed to the noise and dust of the construction. We need to keep windows closed until construction finishes to stop dust from entering our kids bedroom. Our children go to bed at 7:00 pm, we need to have windows open so that they have fresh air (we do not have air conditioning). The proposed extended construction hours will increase noise and dust past their bedtime, disrupting our children's sleep, and potentially having a detrimental impact on their behavior, health and education. Furthermore, the proposed extended construction hours to include Saturday's will further increase dust levels on weekends, meaning that we will need to keep windows closed, and making use of our balcony untenable, particularly in north-east winds which are predominant during summer time. This is a day that we are home together as a family, and the extended hours will have a large and adverse impact on our family life.
