Dear David,

We are writing again to express our ongoing concern with the proposed modification to the approved development at the above address.

Our concerns relate to the extensive movement of groundwater and stormwater in this precinct which is now subject to controls encased in two approved DA's.

MOD 2015/0032 relating to DA2007/0856 (in the name of Minnic/Moorgate) seeks relaxation of Council imposed conditions relating to groundwater movement and controls. These controls were designed to prevent problems in the underground carparke of the proposed developments and to prevent flooding detriment to downstream neighbours.

In a recent storm event, No.20 and 22 Marmora were flooded by storm water flowing across 18 Marmora, as it has historically done in every storm event. On this occasion the flooding was more severe with an already elevated water table.
