Reference is made to Council's referral dated 23 September 2024 regarding the abovementioned application which was referred to Transport for NSW (TfNSW) for comment in accordance with Clause 2.119 of the *State Environment Planning Policy* (*Transport and Infrastructure*) 2021.

TfNSW has reviewed the submitted application and raises no objection as the proposed development is unlikely to have a significant impact on the state classified road network (i.e. Condamine Street and Pittwater Road). Kentwell Road, to which the development site gains vehicle access is a regional road that is not classified under the *Roads Act 1993* and is managed by the Council. TfNSW notes that there are no changes to the vehicle access arrangements to and from Kentwell Road proposed as part of the current application.
