Reasons for referral

This application seeks consent development on land, or within 40m of land, containing:

- All Development Applications on
- Actual or potential threatened species, populations, ecological communities, or their habitats;
- Wildlife corridors;
- Vegetation query stipulating that a Flora and Fauna Assessment is required;
- Vegetation query X type located in both A & C Wards;

And as such, Council's Natural Environment Unit officers are required to consider the likely potential environmental impacts.

Officer comments

The proposed development has been assessed against Manly LEP Clause 6.5 (Terrestrial Biodiversity). It is considered that the proposal is unlikely to result in a substantial impact to existing native vegetation or wildlife and can therefore comply with the control, subject to recommended conditions of consent.

No Planting Environmental Weeds

Reason: To mitigate potential impacts to native wildlife resulting from construction activity.
