Officer comments

Awaiting Council's Bushland & Biodiversity Referral review before any determination from Landscape Referral.

Council's Landscape Referral is assessed against the Pittwater Local Environment Plan (PLEP) clause C4 zone Environmental Living, and the following Pittwater 21 Development Control Plan (PDCP) controls (but not limited to):

- B4.22 Preservation of Trees and Bushland Vegetation
- C1.1 Landscaping
- D4 Church Point and Bayview Locality

The site is located in the C4 Environmental Living zone, requiring development to achieve a scale integrated with the landform and landscape, and to minimise impact on the natural environment with ecological, scientific or aesthetic values, including the retention of natural landscape features and existing trees, to satisfy the landscape objectives of the C4 Environmental Living zone.

The proposal as reported in the Statement of Environmental effects is for a secondary dwelling in the rear yard requiring the removal of one existing tree. It is noted the property falls within the Biodiversity Values Map (BVM) under the Biodiversity Conservation Act, and any tree removal within the BVM may trigger the Biodiversity Offsets Scheme (BOS). This specific matter is deferred to Council's Bushland & Biodiversity Referral team for determination and subsequently Landscape Referral are unable to continue the assessment.

The proposal is therefore unsupported.
