I was present at the Independent Assessment Panel meeting for Optus's 2017 DA at Manly Council Chambers. There were 11 speakers at the meeting. The Panel had the opportunity to question speakers at the close of their speech.

At this meeting I recall that the Panel questioned only one speaker -the Optus representative. The Panel said to the Optus representative that what they would like to see is data that demonstrates a community need for the proposed tower. Optus replied to say they did not have any data to present. What greatly angers me is that here Optus are again, within 300 of a primary school and without a case for community need.

I have noticed that the sentiments being expressed in objection in this DA, are much stronger than in the previous DA. The torment that residents are feeling about the prospect of the current DA being approved is very clear. Do the NBLPP feel that in this DA a case for community need is important? Will the NBLPP be asking Optus in the meeting on Wednesday 7 October 2020, whether they have data to support a need in the community?
