I wish to make a submission objecting to the latest proposed development at 233 Whale Beach Road, Whale Beach.

The increased operating hours, coupled with the increase in numbers and required parking is outrageous. The volume, noise and traffic interference for this now massive rubbish collection at this level will impact on neighbours and early morning visitors to the beach. Are you aware that the potential rubbish room is located a few metres from the next door property? Objections were raised previously, when the volume was much less, and we were then informed that the matter would be dealt with and redesigned. The 'new' design was insulating the rubbish room! This, in no way, dealt with the problem. The noise of the grinding rubbish trucks and the revving of the large collection trucks are not inside the rubbish room! Now, this activity will be massively increased.

When Ripples was in operation, the noise from the late night dinners and functions was, at times, intolerable. We complained many times, calling the police, and finally we were forced to contact the owner of Ripples, Bill Drakopoulos.
