Reasons for referral

This application seeks consent development on land, or within 40m of land, containing:

- All Development Applications on
- Actual or potential threatened species, populations, ecological communities, or their habitats;
- Wildlife corridors;
- Vegetation query stipulating that a Flora and Fauna Assessment is required;
- Vegetation query X type located in both A & C Wards;

And as such, Council's Natural Environment Unit officers are required to consider the likely potential environmental impacts.

Officer comments

The modification application for development consent DA 2019/0263 has been reviewed. The modification application seeks to reduce the extent of hard surfaces on the site to provide a greater area for landscaping and to maximise on-site infiltration of stormwater. The proposed modifications do not adversely impact approved landscaping, the creekline corridor or the wider natural environment.

The proposal is therefore supported.
