### Reasons for referral

This application seeks consent development on land, or within 40m of land, containing:

- All Development Applications on
- Actual or potential threatened species, populations, ecological communities, or their habitats;
- Wildlife corridors;
- Vegetation query stipulating that a Flora and Fauna Assessment is required;
- Vegetation query - X type located in both A & C Wards;

And as such, Council's Natural Environment Unit officers are required to consider the likely potential environmental impacts.

### Officer comments

Council's Natural Environment Unit - Biodiversity referral team have reviewed the application for consistency against the relevant environmental legislation and controls, including:

#### **Biodiversity Conservation Act 2016 (BC Act)** **Warringah Local Environmental Plan (WLEP)** **Warringah Development Control Plan (WDCP)**

- Clause E2 Prescribed Vegetation
- Clause E4 Wildlife Corridors
- Clause E6 Retaining unique environmental features

The application does not require the removal of native vegetation, nor is it likely to indirectly impact nearby biodiversity values. Subject to conditions the Bushland and Biodiversity referral team find the application to be consistent against relevant environmental controls.
