Obtrusive Lighting

Written certification of a suitably qualified professional is to be provided to Council / Accredited Certifier prior to the use of the new lights to demonstrate that the lighting complies with the requirements of AS4282:1997 Control of the Obtrusive Effects of Outdoor Lighting

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Reason: To ensure residential premises are not affected by inappropriate or excessive illumination.

ON-GOING CONDITIONS THAT MUST BE COMPLIED WITH AT ALL TIMES

Use of Sports Fields (and associated Lighting)

The use of the fields (and associated lighting) by any sporting club shall cease by the following times:

- 8:30pm Monday to Thursday with lighting to be turned off by 8:45pm
- 9:00pm Fridays with lighting to be turned off by 9:15pm
- 6.45pm Saturdays with lighting to be turned off by 7.00pm
- 6.00pm Sundays with lighting to be turned off by 6.15pm).

Reason: To preserve the amenity of surrounding residential properties (DACHPGOG5)

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
