Reasons for referral

This application seeks consent for large/and or industrial development.

And as such, Council's Environmental Investigations officers are required to consider the likely impacts.

Officer comments General Comments

This application is seeking consent for the construction of a new multi storey building to be used for the purpose of self-storage units at the site.

Two basement levels are proposed as well as demolition of the existing dwelling and ancillary structures.

Application is seeking consent for 24 hour operation with entry via a security roller door. Noise sources associated with the use of the facility include motor vehicle movements, client voice noise and the operation of the roller door.

An acoustic report has been provided with the application and provided a number of recommendations to minimise noise impacts. The report has determined that the level of noise emission from the use and operation of the facility is predicted to be below the EPA's noise goals at all receptor locations during the day, evening and nighttime periods.

Environmental Health recommends approval subject to conditions.

The proposal is therefore supported.
