Reasons for referral

This application seeks consent for the following:

- Construction / development works within 5 metres of a tree or
- New residential works with three or more dwellings. (RFB's, townhouses, seniors living, guesthouses, etc). or
- Mixed use developments containing three or more residential dwellings.
- New Dwellings or

Officer comments

Amended Landscape Plans are noted.

Condition 15 of the Court issued Consent states:

15. Amended Landscape Plans

i) Landscape Plans are to be amended to delete 2 x Liquidambar styraciflua nominated for canopy planting in the front car-park and substitute with 2 trees not listed on Council's exempt tree species list which are capable of attaining a minimum height of 15 m at maturity. *ii)* Each tree is to be provided with a minimum of 30m3 of sub-surface soil volume via a proprietary load bearing soil cell system. Reason: Environmental amenity (DACLACPCC1)

The amended Landscape Plans indicate replacement planting of *Cupaniopsis anacardioides*. However, C. anacardiodes is a tree species currently listed on Council's exempt tree species list, and is therefore unsuitable.

It is recommended that the species be substituted with *Corymbia maculata*, which can be achieved via condition as follows:

Amended Landscape Plans

i) Landscape Plans are to be amended to delete *Cupaniopsis anacardioides* from the planting list and substitute with *Corymbia maculata*, minimum pot size 75 litre.

Reason: Environmental amenity (DACLACPCC1)

No other objections are raised to the amended plans.



The proposal is therefore supported.
