Officer comments

This application was assessed in consideration of:

- Supplied plans and reports;
- Northern Beaches Water Management for Development Policy (WM Policy), and;
- Relevant LEP and DCP clauses;

The proposed modifications are not impacting the court approved stormwater quality management system.

The geotechnical report from STS (23/267 LI/js, 08/08/2023) is stating that the removal of basement 2 is mitigating the risk of groundwater interference. Possible seepage in basement 1 and site rainfall might require dewatering during construction.

If the need for Water Managements Act (WMA) approvals only becomes apparent following development consent, applicants should be referred directly to WaterNSW.

No objections regarding water management

The proposal is therefore supported.

CONDITIONS TO BE COMPLIED WITH DURING DEMOLITION AND BUILDING WORK

Dewatering Management

A permit from Council is required for any dewatering of seepage and tailwater.

The groundwater/tailwater to be discharged must be compliant with the General Terms of Approval/Controlled Activity permit issued by WaterNSW (if applicable), Landcom's 'Managing Urban

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Stormwater: Soils and Construction' (2004) (Blue Book), Council's Compliance and Enforcement Policy and legislation including Protection of the Environment Operations Act 1997 and Contaminated Lands Act 1997.

All approvals, water discharges and monitoring results are to be documented and kept on site. Copies of all records shall be provided to the appropriate regulatory authority, including Council, upon request.

Reason: Protection of the receiving environment and groundwater resources.

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
