

## Natural Environment Referral Response - Biodiversity

### Reasons for referral

This application seeks consent development on land, or within 40m of land, containing:

- All Development Applications on
- Actual or potential threatened species, populations, ecological communities, or their habitats;
- Wildlife corridors;
- Vegetation query stipulating that a Flora and Fauna Assessment is required;
- Vegetation query - X type located in both A & C Wards;

And as such, Council's Natural Environment Unit officers are required to consider the likely potential environmental impacts.

### Officer comments

The proposal has been assessed against the following provisions:

- SEPP (Coastal Management) - Coastal Environment Area
- Pittwater LEP Clause 7.6 (Biodiversity Protection)
- Pittwater DCP Clause B4.5 Landscape and Flora and Fauna Enhancement Category 3 Land

Compliance with the relevant provisions is dependent upon retention/replacement of protected native trees. Conditions of consent recommended by Council's Landscape referral body have addressed this objective including the requirement for appropriate compensatory planting. Subject to recommended conditions, the proposal is considered to comply with the controls.

The proposal is therefore supported.

#### No Planting Environmental Weeds
