This application seeks consent for large/and or industrial development.

And as such, Council's Environmental Investigations officers are required to consider the likely impacts.

Officer comments General Comments

The proposal involves some demolition however no earthworks or excavation is proposed.

The ongoing use of the marina berths themselves pose no expected amenity impacts in terms of unreasonable noise generation, however the building works stage has the potential to create noise nuisance.

The construction management plan as noted in the statement of environmental effects is to be provided prior to the issue of a construction certificate.

Environmental Health supports the proposal and recommends a condition of consent for noise mitigation measures to be put in place during works as part of the construction management plan.
