As a local resident and with 3 children at St Rose Catholic Primary School my family and I are extremely concerned about the Development Application to erect a new mobile phone tower at RSL Lifecare (the War Vets) and the electromagnetic radiation (EMR) emanating from the proposed tower.

Mobile tower waves can have a serious impact on people who are within 500 metres of the site. I do not want my or any other kids to be exposed to this at school 6 hours a day.

Studies have shown that people living within 300m of such a tower showed an increased rate of unpleasant symptoms including nausea, loss of appetite, visual disruptions and difficulty in moving, Irritability, depression, concentration problems, memory loss, dizziness and reduced libido. Headaches, sleep problems, feelings of discomfort and skin problems. High rate of fatigue.

A study conducted in Brazil found that those who lived within 500 metres of a phone tower had a higher mortality rate than the average mortality rate of the entire city.

Having walked all across most of the Northern Beaches bushland and National Parks surely you could construct this tower somewhere in this area (as some of it is just scrubland) rather than in a built up residential area in close proximity to schools.
