Morning Paula,

As discussed on the phone please see the following which is an extract of the legislation section of our report:

As the proposal relates to a special fire protection purpose it is subject to s. 100B of the Rural Fire Protection Purpose use.

Also in addition s4.14 of the act states:

Development consent cannot be granted for the carrying out of development for any purpose (other than a subdivision of land that could lawfully be used for residential or rural on a relevant map certified under section 10.3(2)) unless the consent authority

(a) is satisfied that the development conforms to the specifications and requirements of the version (as prescribed by the regulations) of the document entitled Planning for Bush Fire Protection prepared by the regulations for the purposes of this paragraph, that document) that are relevant to the development (the relevant specifications and requirements), or

(b) has been provided with a certificate by a person who is recognised by the NSW Rural Fire Service as a qualified consultant in bush fire risk assessment stating that the development conforms to the relevant specifications and requirements.

Therefore in accordance with this it is our understanding that a Bushfire Certificate under s4.14 is not required as it is Special Fire Protection purpose under s100B of the Rural Fires Act and should be referred to the NSW Rural Fire Service.
