Reference is made to Council's email dated 19 February 2019, regarding the abovementioned application which was referred to Roads and Maritime Services (Roads and Maritime) for comment in accordance with *State Environmental Planning Policy (Infrastructure)* 2007.

Roads and Maritime has reviewed the submitted documentation and requests following information for further assessment:

- 1. Amended plans are to be submitted relocating the proposed driveway further away from the existing signalised intersection. Roads and Maritime request that the driveway be located as close to the western property boundary as possible.
- 2. Amended plans are to be submitted clearly identifying the proposed loading bay location. The location of proposed loading bay signage should also be shown.
- 3. Swept path plans should be provided for review showing the longest vehicle entering and exiting the subject site. The swept path of the longest vehicle (including garbage trucks, building maintenance vehicles, removalists and construction vehicles) entering and exiting the subject site, as well as manoeuvrability through the site, shall be in accordance with AUSTROADS. The swept paths are to demonstrate that vehicles can enter and exit the site simultaneously.
