


3.2 The premise is located within the Northern Beaches Police Area Command and the Northern Beaches Local Government Area (LGA).

#### 4. Crime Data

- 4.1 The Alcohol Related Crime Information Exchange (ARCIE) highlights the involvement of alcohol in specific crime types.
- 4.2 Data from the July 2021 until June 2022 shows 39% of all Assaults and 25% of all Domestic Violence incidents were alcohol related, which occurred within the Northern Beaches PAC, as illustrated below:

# Alcohol Linking Monthly Report LAC: NORTHERN BEACHES PAC (Jul 2021 to Jun 2022)



- (a) "Total POI" and "Total VIC" measure the number of Persons (by involvement type) who responded YES to O1 (had they consumed alcohol prior to the incident).
- (b) "Total ARC Incidents" measures the total number of Incidents where alcohol had been consumed prior.
  (c) "Total Incidents" shows all incidents for each month, with or without alcohol consumption. Therefore Total ARC Incidents/Total Incidents \* 100 = % of Crime that is Alcohol Related.
- (d) "Domestic Violence" is any Incident Category with an associated factor of Domestic Violence Related (e) "All Incidents" counts all incidents excluding "Traffic", "Business Inspection" and "Traffic Offence".

#### 4.3 This equates to:

284 Alcohol Related Assaults **543** Alcohol Related Domestic Violence incidents

- 5.2 If the application is approved police request the following conditions are strongly considered for inclusions onto the licence for the sole purpose of **Public Safety**:
  - 1. The applicant will ensure that there are at least 3 security guards, and two responsible service of alcohol staff members present for the entire duration of the event.
    - a. responsible service of alcohol marshals will have the sole role of observing and monitoring levels of intoxication and are not to complete other roles e.g. service of alcohol.
    - b. The Security guards must be present for 30mins after the event concludes or until the last patron leaves the vicinity of the licensed premise.
  - 2. No open containers of alcohol are permitted to taken off the licensed boundary of the event.
  - Food of a substantial nature will be available on site for the duration of the event.
  - 4. Immediately after the person in charge of the licensed premises or a staff member becomes aware of any incident involving an act of violence causing injury to a person on the premises, the person in charge of the licensed premises and/or staff member must:
    - a. take all practical steps to preserve and keep intact the area where the act of violence occurred.
    - retain all material and implements associated with the act of violence in accordance with the crime scene preservation guidelines issued by NSW Police, as published from time to time on the Liquor and Gaming NSW website,
    - c. make direct and personal contact with NSW Police to advise it of the incident, and
    - d. comply with any directions given by NSW Police to preserve or keep intact the area where the violence occurred.
    - e. In this condition, 'staff member' means any person employed by, or acting on behalf of, the licensee of the premises, and includes any person who is employed to carry on security activities (eg. crowd controller or bouncer) on or about the premises.
