### Making a planning application to a council

Under section 147(5) of the Act a person who makes a *relevant public submission* to a council in relation to a relevant planning application made to the council is required to disclose the following reportable political donations and gifts (if any) made by the person making the submission or any *associate of that person* within the period commencing 2 years before the submission is made and ending when the application is determined

- (a) all reportable political donations made to any local councillor of that council
- (b) all gifts made to any local councillor or employee of that council

A reference in sections 147(4) and 147(5) of the Act to a reportable political donation made to a local councillor includes a reference to a donation made at the time the person was a candidate for election to the council

### How and when do you make a disclosure?

The disclosure of a reportable political donation or gift under section 147 of the Act is to be made

- (a) in or in a statement accompanying the relevant planning application or submission if the donation or gift is made before the application or submission is made or
- (b) If the donation or gift is made afterwards in a statement of the person to whom the relevant planning application or submission was made within 7 days after the donation or gift is made

### What information needs to be in a disclosure?

The information requirements of the disclosure are outlined in the Act under section 147(9) for political donations and section 147(10) for gifts

### Re Planning Proposal 23B Macpherson St, Warriewood - R0002/09

I write to express my interest in and significant concern regarding the above Planning Proposal I have set out my comments below accordingly

As a local resident, who will be relatively directly impacted by any retail development on our street, I would like to state my support for the development of an appropriately sized and planned retail space on the land in question but lodge an objection against the significantly larger supermarket now apparently under consideration

The increased residential numbers within the Warriewood area appear to self-evidently support the need for a retail space that meets the daily shopping needs of residents. At an anecdotal level, the support of local residents for a small set of shops is, I believe, also apparent

Indeed this proposition is put forward within the Proposal itself. It could quite cogently be argued, however, that the apparent inconsistencies throughout the remainder of the Proposal, appear to highlight the disjunction between the originally planned 'small neighbourhood shops' designed to meet this need and the significantly larger supermarket currently under consideration. My concerns speak specifically to the large supermarket, which is arguably in breach of the Proposal wording itself.

I note that the opening objective of the Proposal is to enable a retail development that will service the daily needs of residents in the Warriewood area. A retail space to meet the daily shopping needs of local residents, clearly does not entail a development of the size and scale as put forward by the proponent

Furthermore, the Proposal at A3, specifically references the most recent (2006) assessment by HillPDA, commissioned on behalf of the Council, which cites the appropriateness of a supermarket of no more than 800 square metres with associated floorspace for specialty retailing

The subsequent 2009 analysis, also by HillPDA, albeit at the expense of the proponent, indicates a much larger size retail space may be viable. It is pertinent to note, however, that this would only be

considered viable by 2012 and of the most salience is the obvious disjunction between this significantly enlarged retail space and the previously proposed and allowed set of 'neighbourhood shops' for which the land was, at least until now, legally zoned

My objection to the much larger supermarket is the significant social impact on local residents, not something apparently garnered in any detail in the Proposal. A large supermarket will unquestionably have significant traffic, environmental and social impacts on the surrounding area. Whilst these impacts can only be accurately gauged by those qualified in the relevant fields of expertise, it would appear reasonable to surmise that the impact would be both significant and detrimental

Perhaps, the aspect of most immediate to concern, to those of us using the roads on daily basis, is the increased traffic flow in an area not serviced by traffic lights and with roads that are neither kept in a condition to support the increased traffic congestion nor able to support the addition of heavy vehicles as necessitated by the addition of a large supermarket. As a parent of young children, this increased traffic also presents both safety and pollution concerns

I would urge the Council to reconsider the Proposal as it currently stands to ensure that any retail development is confined to an appropriate scale and size. A corner store, or similar, with associated newsagency, cafe etc would, I believe, find the support of most residents keen to be able to utilize local shops but not have our lifestyle adversely impacted by a large supermarket akin to those already available and within the close vicinity of both Warriewood and Mona Vale.
