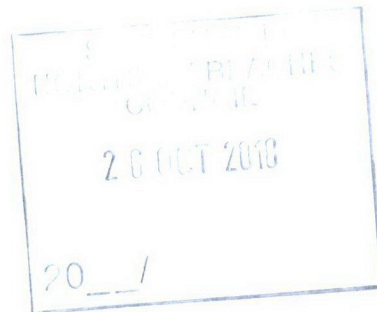


**Re: Proposal NOC 2018 1481**

Dear Sir/Madam,

We, the owners of 42 Ennerdale Crescent Wheeler Heights object to the proposal and have forwarded this to Northern Beaches Council before the closing date of 22<sup>nd</sup> October 2018.

Our objection is based on the following:

1. The proposal is an unsightly intrusion on the environment in this area. Properties were built here because of the natural state of the land. It is one of the few developments that retains its beauty.
2. The proposal is detrimental to health. A significant number of Doctors world-wide who have investigated this issue in detail have declared it to be so. Council and Company Groups should not close their eyes to more intellectual research than they have accumulated,
  - a. firstly, because their research is significantly better than Council's or a company's, and
  - b. secondly because the Council is working for the community and needs to maintain that when researching or approving of work to be done.
3. Property valuation will be reduced because of this proposal.
4. Future young families will choose not to buy into this location because of this proposal. This can result in an imbalance of population which is already beginning to show an imbalance of working young people and seniors
5. The families and the seniors that do reside here should not be subject to a proposal that interferes with their health no matter how this may be helpful to a particular group who want it for their own personal reasons. I.e. internet is spotty in one part of the War Vets accommodation.
