CONDITIONS TO BE SATISFIED PRIOR TO THE ISSUE OF THE CONSTRUCTION CERTIFICATE

Stormwater Disposal

Stormwater shall be disposed of to an existing approved system or in accordance with Northern Beaches Council's PITTWATER DCP21,

A hydraulic report prepared by a suitably qualified civil engineer demonstrating the existing approved system can accommodate the additional flows is to be submitted to the Principal Certifying Authority for approval prior to the issue of the Construction Certificate.

Reason: To ensure appropriate provision for disposal and stormwater management arising from



development.

Stormwater Disposal

Engineering Plans in accordance with the requirements of section 3.1.2 Drainage of the Building Code of Australia Housing Provision and AS/NZS 3500.3.2:1998 - Stormwater Drainage – Acceptable solutions are to be submitted and certified by an appropriately qualified and practicing Civil Engineer, indicating all details relevant to the collection and disposal of stormwater from the site, buildings, paved areas and where appropriate adjacent catchments. Stormwater shall be conveyed from the site to the existing stormwater drainage system.

Details demonstrating compliance are to be submitted to the Principal Certifying Authority for approval prior to the issue of the Construction Certificate.

Reason: To ensure appropriate provision for disposal and stormwater management arising from the development.

Geotechnical Report Recommendations have been Incorporated into Designs and Structural Plans

Prior to issue of the Construction Certificate, Form 2 of the Geotechnical Risk Management Policy for Pittwater (Appendix 5 of P21 DCP) is to be completed and submitted to the Accredited Certifier. The recommendations of risk assessment to manage hazards as identified in the Geotechnical Report prepared by Davis Geotechnical Consulting Engineers dated 29 January 2018 are to be incorporated into the construction plans.

Reason: To ensure geotechnical risk is mitigated appropriately

elevated car parking bays - construction

The elevated car parking bays are to be fully suspended off the natural ground levels. Structural

engineering plans in accordance with the Davies Geotectnical Consulting Engineers report dated 29

January 2018 are to be submitted to the PCA prior to the issue of the construction certificate.

Reason: To minimize impacts on natural vegetation (DACENCPCC4)

CONDITIONS TO BE COMPLIED WITH DURING DEMOLITION AND BUILDING WORK

Temporary Sediment

Temporary sedimentation and erosion controls are to be constructed prior to commencement of any work to eliminate the discharge of sediment from the site.

Reason: To reduce erosion and prevent sediment runoff into public assets

Maintenance of Sediment

Sedimentation and erosion controls are to be effectively maintained at all times during the course of construction and shall not be removed until the site has been stabilised or landscaped to the Principal Certifying Authority's satisfaction.



CONDITIONS WHICH MUST BE COMPLIED WITH PRIOR TO THE ISSUE OF THE OCCUPATION CERTIFICATE

Stormwater Disposal

The stormwater drainage works shall be certified as compliant with all relevant Australian Standards and Codes by a suitably qualified person. Details demonstrating compliance are to be submitted to the Principal Certifying Authority prior to the issue of any interim / final Occupation Certificate.

Reason: To ensure appropriate provision for the disposal of stormwater arising from the development.

Geotechnical Certification Recommendations have been Implemented

Prior to issue of the Occupation Certificate, Form 3 of the Geotechnical Risk Management Policy (Appendix 5 of P21 DCP) is to be completed and submitted to the Accredited Certifier.

Reason: To ensure geotechnical risk is mitigated appropriately.
