Consideration of Application

The proposal seeks consent for the construction of a garage and studio. The proposed works include the demolition of the existing carport and hardstand and the construction of a new double garage with a first floor studio. The proposed studio will contain a bathroom and balcony, as well as an access door and stairs. The proposed works also include the construction of a new driveway to accommodate access to the proposed garage. The heritage listed street trees are located to the north of the subject property along the north and south sides of Lodge Street. Given the proposed works are contained within the existing footprint of the subject property, and there is an appropriate distance between the location of the proposed works and streets trees, the proposal is not considered to impact upon the heritage item nor impact its significance.

Therefore, Heritage raises no objections to the proposal and requires no conditions.
