- The 2 trees nearest to Morgan Rd, (1) & (2), roots from the trees are
 growing under the artificial grass/turf and causing large ridges across the
 playing area and children have tripped over them and the preschool have
 had 2 broken arms as a result, they have also dropped some big
 branches.
- The preschool are expecting a visit from the dept of OH&S to evaluate their grading and to see what action we are taking.
- The other 2 large trees (3) & (4) should be also removed as they have dropped large branches on to the play area and we were very fortunate that there were no children in the play area at the time, as they could have caused serious injury or death.
