I love the Northern Beaches and want to see the beach and ocean amenity preserved for the majority. I see the Collaroy wall situation as a precedent for other walls that will be required around Australia as climate change leads to sea level rise. I would like to see demonstrated a solution that will protect the Collaroy and other beaches into the future. It's a shame those properties were allowed to be built on inappropriate land.

I am lodging an objection to DA2021/1612 regarding the construction of a vertical beachfront seawall on the following grounds:

- (i) A vertical wall constructed on the ocean front will have long term detrimental effect on the beach. Instead, consideration should be given to the construction of a revetment (sloping) wall. Following times of high storm activity causing beach sand erosion, the beach will recover more quickly with a sloping rock revetment wall;
- (ii) The DA submitted proposes that a seawall is constructed on the beachfront in front of the houses and apartment buildings from 1 Clarke Street to 1204 Pittwater Road, however it does not indicate what is proposed for the area in front of South Narrabeen SLSC.
- (iii) The proposed vertical seawall will exacerbate massive erosion along the beachfront. The DA does not adequately indicate how beach sand nourishment will occur to restore the beach.

I hope that a thorough scientific assessment is being made of the current wall and no other similar walls are built without expert independent evidence gathered and used to guide future plans.
