

### Environmental Health Referral Response - unsewered land

#### Reasons for referral

This application seeks consent for development upon unsewered land.

And as such, Council's Environmental Health and Protection officers are required to consider the likely impacts.

## Officer comments General Comments

An Approval to Install the proposed on-site wastewater system has been given by Environmental Health in August, prior to the DA being lodged - see TRIM folder for WW00922. Thus, we are satisfied with the proposal and advise that no conditions need to be included.

Our only concern is that a disposal area for pool backwash has not been nominated and so it is not known where this discharged water will be sent. The applicant should provide provision for on-site management of pool backwash to demonstrate that it will not be discharged in contravention of *Protection of Environment Operations Act 1997*, whereby 'only pure water may be released into the environment'.

The proposal is therefore supported.

# CONDITIONS TO BE SATISFIED PRIOR TO THE ISSUE OF THE CONSTRUCTION CERTIFICATE

### Designated pool back-wash absorption trench

A trench designated for contaminated water to discharged/back-washed from the pool must:

- be included in the plans provided to the Principal Certifying Authority;
- not affect the on-site sewage management system;
- not be released into Council storm water infrastructure; and
- be done into a designated trench on-site.

Reason: Prevent water pollution according to Protection of Environment Operations Act 1997 and relevant regulations.

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## ON-GOING CONDITIONS THAT MUST BE COMPLIED WITH AT ALL TIMES

### Pool water discharge/backwash

Contaminated water (anything other than pure) which is discharged/backwashed from the pool must:

- not affect the on-site sewage management system;
- not be released into Council storm water infrastructure; and
- be done into a designated trench on-site.

Reason: Prevent water pollution according to Protection of Environment Operations Act 1997 and relevant regulations.

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
