We are writing to advise that the request to modify the above-mentioned Development Consent has been approved on 8 September 2005 and determined as follows:

• Condition 18 be altered to read:

- 18 (a) The applicant is to provide a minimum of 960 on-site parking spaces for use by staff.
 - (b) The applicant may charge a fee for staff parking.
 - (c) The proposed fee for staff parking spaces will not be enforced:
 (i) between 7pm on Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Fridays and Saturdays and 6am the following day;

Please be aware however, that work on the site in relation to this amendment **cannot** proceed unless a Construction Certificate application for the modification proposal has been lodged with and subsequently approved by Council or an Accredited Certifier.

Work must also be in accordance with the relevant conditions of the Development Consent.
