- 1. Property address: Phyllis Stewart building, 4 Edmondson Drive, Narrabeen NSW 2101.
- 2. Development:

The proposed development is addition of Dining Room to the existing Phyllis Stewart building within the campus of the RSL Veteran's Retirement Village at Narrabeen, refer to Humel Architects' drawings DA01DA, DA02DA, DA03DA, DA04DA, DA05DA and DA06DA (reduced A4 copies attached). Under Planning for Bush Fire Proptection the proposal is classified as an infill development. As the proposal is a Retired Aged Care Facility it is considered a 'Special Fire Protection Purpose' and a Bushfire Safety Authority is requested to be issued by the Rural Fire Services upon validation of this assessment report.

- 3. Bushfire mapping: The site is within the Warringah Bush Fire Prone Land Map 2010.
- 4. Requirements of Planning for Bush Fire Protection 2006 (with Addendum: Appendix 3 2010):

The proposed new Dining Room is more than 100 metres from the nearest bushfire hazard. Jamieson Park which is north of Coolooli Road is about 198 metres away. The edge of forest within the campus west of Endeavour Drive is 245 metres away. The risk of bushfire attack is Low and no construction standard under AS3959 is required. Refer to attached Aerial photo map with marked-up scaled distances.
