New South Wales Police have received Development Consent Application Number DA2022/1100 from Bucketty's Brewing Co. located at 26 ORCHARD RD BROOKVALE . The applicant is seeking a Development Application for a five events. The application has been reviewed and police would like to provide the following response.

**1. Application**

- 1.1 The application relates to licensed premise **Bucketty's Brewing Co.** (hereafter referred to as the 'premise').
- 1.2 The application seeks to obtain a Development Application for 5 Events for the temporary use of the land to occur in a similar manner do DA2022/1100, but for five (5) times per annum, each time within a 24-hour period.
- 1.3 The capacity of the premise, as per development approval, is 500 persons.

**2. Applicant**

- 2.1 Police have conducted a number of checks on the Computerised Operational Policing System (COPS) in relation to the applicant **Nicholas MCDONALD** and have found **no relevant** adverse incidents recorded against the applicant in the previous ten years.

**3. Location**

- 3.1 The premise is located at **26 ORCHARD RD BROOKVALE**
- 3.2 The premise is located within the Northern Beaches Police Area Command and the Northern Beaches

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NSW Police Force

Local Government Area (LGA).

#### 4. Crime Data

4.1 The Alcohol Related Crime Information Exchange (**ARCIE**) highlights the involvement of alcohol in specific crime types.

4.2 Data from the July 2021 until June 2022 shows **39% of all Assaults** and **25% of all Domestic Violence incidents** were alcohol related, which occurred within the Northern Beaches PAC, as illustrated below:

- (a) "Total POI" and "Total VIC" measure the number of Persons (by involvement type) who responded YES to Q1 (had they consumed alcohol prior to the incident).  
 (b) "Total ARC Incidents" measures the total number of Incidents where alcohol had been consumed prior.  
 (c) "Total Incidents" shows all incidents for each month, with or without alcohol consumption. Therefore Total ARC Incidents/Total Incidents \* 100 = % of Crime that is Alcohol Related.  
 (d) "Domestic Violence" is any Incident Category with an associated factor of Domestic Violence Related.

#### 5. Comment

5.1 Police have reviewed the application and **do not object** to the application being granted.

5.2 If the application is approved police request the following conditions are strongly considered for inclusions onto the licence for the sole purpose of **Public Safety**:

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1. The applicant will notify Council and Police 28 days prior to the use of the premise for any of the five (5) events.
2. Council and Police may impose further restrictions based upon the type and style of events selected by the applicant if it differs from the style or manner identified in DA2022/1100.
3. The applicant will ensure that there are at least the following staff during the five (5) events according to expected patron capacity or actual capacity whichever is higher:

**500 Patrons**

- a. 3 security guards, and two responsible service of alcohol staff members present for the entire duration of the event.
- b. responsible service of alcohol marshals will have the sole role of observing and monitoring levels of intoxication and are not to complete other roles e.g. service of alcohol.
- c. The Security guards must be present for 30mins after the event concludes or until the last patron leaves the vicinity of the licensed premise.

**400 Patron**

- d. 2 security guards, and two responsible service of alcohol staff members present for the entire duration of the event.
- e. responsible service of alcohol marshals will have the sole role of observing and monitoring levels of intoxication and are not to complete other roles e.g. service of alcohol.
- f. The Security guards must be present for 30mins after the event concludes or until the last patron leaves the vicinity of the licensed premise.

**300 Patrons or less**

- g. Two (2) security guards, and one (1) responsible service of alcohol staff members present for the entire duration of the event.
- h. responsible service of alcohol marshals will have the sole role of observing and monitoring levels of intoxication and are not to complete other roles e.g. service of alcohol.
- i. The Security guards must be present for 30mins after the event concludes or until the last patron leaves the vicinity of the licensed premise.

4. No open containers of alcohol are permitted to taken off the licensed boundary of the event.
5. Food of a substantial nature will be available on site for the duration of the event.
6. Immediately after the person in charge of the licensed premises or a staff member becomes aware of any incident involving an act of violence causing injury to a person on the premises, the person in charge of the licensed premises and/or staff member must:
  - a. take all practical steps to preserve and keep intact the area where the act of violence occurred,
  - b. retain all material and implements associated with the act of violence in accordance with the

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- crime scene preservation guidelines issued by NSW Police, as published from time to time on the Liquor and Gaming NSW website,
- c. make direct and personal contact with NSW Police to advise it of the incident, and
  - d. comply with any directions given by NSW Police to preserve or keep intact the area where the violence occurred.
  - e. In this condition, 'staff member' means any person employed by, or acting on behalf of, the licensee of the premises, and includes any person who is employed to carry on security activities (eg. crowd controller or bouncer) on or about the premises.
