I live at Tango Avenue, Dee Why and I want to let Council know that the public pathway from Tango Avenue down to Pittwater Road (near Stoney Range Reserve) is in use day and night by my family (multiple times a day, every day of the week). I know it is also used heavily by the staff at Delmar Hospital who are coming and going from the bus stop for their shifts.

Due to the new apartment development at the end of the stairs we have partially lost access to the steps.

The purpose of my email is to plead with council to keep this important access open. To lose this access would mean we would need to drive in to Dee Why more often to access the shops and public transport adding further congestion to Dee Why.
