To whom it may concern,

On behalf of Manly Golf Club I would like to raise concerns following last year's Drop Music Festival at Kierle Park.

In March last year I contacted Ken O'Brien from the Drop Festival to enquire as to the security arrangements they had for the festival as we have often had problems with trespassers on our property when events are held at Kierle Park. Ken advised me they had security around the perimeter of the property and patrons from the event would not be able to access our property from Kierle Park.

Unfortunately on the day we had 50+ teenagers jumping the fences to our property in an attempt to make entry to the Festival via the Golf Course which borders Kierle Park. As our staff were unable to manage the number of people trespassing our property I called Manly Police Station to provide assistance and they were able to send a patrol car.

Without security being provided to the boundary of our property, along Addiscombe, Kenneth & Balgowlah Roads, there is no doubt we will have the same problems with trespassing and damage to our property once again.

We are happy for the application to be approved on the basis the Festival's promoters provide sufficient security staff to protect the boundaries of Manly Golf Club's property on Addiscombe, Kenneth and Balgowlah Roads.
