I have read the traffic management assessment, however I have had great difficulty getting to my property during the afternoon school pick up period in particular (but also in the morning).

Many of the roads around Angophora Circuit are one way and narrow roads with vehicles parked on both sides. I have spent up 20 minutes trying to access my property from the roundabout to my garage as the whole area is totally gridlocked.

Some of the older students who drive park their vehicles in the residential streets adding to traffic gridlock.

Some of the parents also use our streets to exit the school trying to avoid the congestions on Forest Road.

All residents in the streets below the school around Angophora Circuit, Casuarina Drive, Echidna Way etc must use the roundabout.

Cars accessing Forest Rd, block the roundabout totally while trying to access the school, rather than allowing others to drive down Macpherson or Ponderosa Rd.

Assistance at the roundabout during the school pick up and drop off would be appreciated.

Alternatively drop off/pick up bays south of the roundabout in Macpherson street would prevent the roundabout being blocked and allow other residents to exit their streets.

Many of the residents of the Cape apartments are retirees as they were built for over 55s, plus there are some with disabilities living there.

As the school is surrounded by bush, in a bushfire emergency this area would be totally gridlocked if the school needed to evacuate and the surrounding residents as well.

Another exit/access point for the school would be advisable.
