HERITAGE COMMENTS Discussion of reason for referral

The proposal has been referred to Heritage as the subject site is within proximity to two heritage listed items:

Item I191 - Street trees - Pacific Parade

Item I2 - All stone kerbs

Details of heritage items affected

Details of the item as contained within the Manly heritage inventory is as follows:

Item I191 - Street trees

<u>Statement of significance:</u> Listed for its aesthetic importance to the streetscape. <u>Physical description:</u> Avenue planting of mixed tree species planted in carriageway. Species include Port Jackson Fig, Brush Box and Camphor Laurel.

Item I2 - All stone kerbs

Statement of significance:

Stone kerbs are heritage listed.

Physical description:

Sandstone kerbing to streets relating to paving and kerbing of streets in the nineteenth century. Mostly located within Manly Village area and adjacent lower slopes of Eastern Hill and Fairlight.

Consideration of Application

The proposal seeks consent for modifications to the approved DA2018/1187, including the retention of the front garden and the existing carport and modifications to the location and size of the pool at the rear. The site is in a highly distinctive area with predominant streetscape qualities, such as building form, scale, patterns, materials, colours and vegetation such as the heritage listed street trees that contributes the character of the local area. Given that the proposed changes are minor in nature and do not detract from the predominant streetscape qualities, the proposed works are considered to not impact upon the significance of the heritage items.

CONDITIONS TO BE COMPLIED WITH DURING DEMOLITION AND BUILDING WORK

Protection of heritage listed stone kerb

Care should be taken to ensure that the heritage listed stone kerb in Pacific Parade is not damaged as a result of construction works.

Reason: To ensure the heritage listed kerbs are protected.

Protection of heritage listed street trees

The street tree, located in the road reserve outside 6 Pacific Parade, Manly, is to be protected at all times during demolition and construction works on the site.

Reason: To ensure that the heritage listed street trees are not damaged as a result of the proposed works.
