The application seeks consent for alterations and additions to an existing dwelling. The proposed works include the construction of a new swimming pool and spa located at the front of the dwelling, a new balcony at the front of the existing living room, an addition and new patio across the rear of the dwelling and an increase in the garage roof height to accommodate a car stacker. Further

the dwelling and an increase in the garage roof height to accommodate a car stacker. Further proposed works include the construction of two new balconies and an extension on the first floor. The heritage listed Fisher Bay Reserve is located to the south of the subject property. Heritage notes there is substantial distance between the heritage item and the subject property which is separated by several lanes of traffic along Manly Road. Given the physical separation between the subject property and the heritage item, Heritage raises no concerns and requires no conditions.
