

## **Natural Environment Referral Response - Biodiversity**

#### Reasons for referral

This application seeks consent development on land, or within 40m of land, containing:

- All Development Applications on
- Actual or potential threatened species, populations, ecological communities, or their habitats;
- Wildlife corridors;
- Vegetation query stipulating that a Flora and Fauna Assessment is required;
- Vegetation query X type located in both A & C Wards;

And as such, Council's Natural Environment Unit officers are required to consider the likely potential environmental impacts.

#### Officer comments

This application was assessed under Warringah DCP E2 Prescribed vegetation and E6 Retaining unique environmental features.

The proposal is to demolish the existing dwelling and construct a new 3 storey, 5 bedroom dwelling. No native trees or vegetation are proposed to be removed or impacted as a result of the proposed works.

The submitted Landscape Plan includes exotic species and no canopy tree plantings. One native canopy tree is required to be planted which will reach a minimum height of 8.5m to comply with controls.

Council's Natural Environment - Biodiversity section supports the application, subject to conditions.

# CONDITIONS TO BE SATISFIED PRIOR TO THE ISSUE OF THE CONSTRUCTION CERTIFICATE

#### **Amendment of Landscape Plans**

The submitted Landscape Plan is to be amended in accordance with the following:

- Deletion of 30 x Tibouchina Jazzie
- Replacement with locally native vegetation species (as per species listed in the Native Gardening Booklet available on Councils website)

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- Provision of one native canopy tree which will reach a minimum height of 8.5m at maturity (as per species listed in the Native Gardening Booklet available on Councils website)

The amended Landscape Plan is to be certified by a qualified landscape architect, arborist or ecologist prior to issue of the Construction Certificate.

Reason: To ensure landscaping is consistent with relevant Natural Environment LEP/DCP controls.

# CONDITIONS WHICH MUST BE COMPLIED WITH PRIOR TO THE ISSUE OF THE OCCUPATION CERTIFICATE

### **Certification of Landscape Plan**

Landscaping is to be implemented in accordance with the approved Landscape Plans and these conditions of consent. The new landscaping is to be certified as complete and in accordance with approved Landscape Plans and these conditions of consent by a qualified landscape architect, arborist or ecologist prior to issue of any Occupation Certificate.

Reason: To ensure landscaping is consistent with relevant Natural Environment LEP/DCP controls.

## ON-GOING CONDITIONS THAT MUST BE COMPLIED WITH AT ALL TIMES

#### **Control of Weeds**

Prior to the completion of works, all priority weeds (as listed under the Biosecurity Act 2015) are to be removed/controlled within the subject site using an appropriately registered control method. Information on weeds of the Northern Beaches can be found at the NSW WeedWise website (http://weeds.dpi.nsw.gov.au/). All environmental weeds are to be removed and controlled. Refer to Council website http://www.pittwater.nsw.gov.au/environment/noxious\_weeds

**Reason:** Weed management.

### **Canopy Tree Planting**

Tree planting required under this consent are to be retained for the life of the development and/or for their safe natural life. Trees that die or are removed must be replaced with another locally native canopy tree.

Reason: To replace locally native trees in accordance with relevant Natural Environment LEP/DCP controls.

#### **No Planting Environmental Weeds**

No environmental weeds are to be planted on the site. Information on weeds of the Northern Beaches can be found at the NSW WeedWise website (http://weeds.dpi.nsw.gov.au/).

**Reason:** Weed management.

#### Works to cease if item found

If any Aboriginal Engravings or Relics are unearthed all work is to cease immediately and the Aboriginal Heritage Office (AHO) and Office of Environment and Heritage (OEH) are to be notified.

**Reason:** To protect Aboriginal Heritage.

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## **Dead or Injured Wildlife**

If construction activity associated with this development results in injury or death of a native mammal, bird, reptile or amphibian, a registered wildlife rescue and rehabilitation organisation must be contacted for advice.

Reason: To mitigate potential impacts to native wildlife resulting from construction activity.

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
