The proposal requires the removal/relocation of the accessible 167 bus stop in Dowling Street, adversely impacting public transport access for disabled public transport commuters to the commercial centre of Freshwater.

My son who is 13 has vision impairment and mobility disabilities. He uses this bus stop to get home from school in Manly. This stop is close and accessible to his home at 11 Lawrence Street. Removing this stop will require him to walk further to home and over uneven terrain from the prior stop near Crown Street.
