Officer comments

The application as described in reports and as illustrated on plans is assessed by Landscape Referral against the Pittwater Local Environment Plan (PLEP) clause C4 zone Environmental Living, and the following Pittwater 21 Development Control Plan (PDCP) controls (but not limited to): B4.22 Preservation of Trees and Bushland Vegetation; C1.1 Landscaping; and D4 Church Point and Bayview Locality. The site is located in the C4 Environmental Living zone, requiring development to achieve a scale integrated with the landform and landscape, and to minimise impact on the natural environment with ecological, scientific or aesthetic values, including the retention of natural landscape features and existing trees, to satisfy the landscape objectives of the C4 Environmental Living zone.

The submitted Arboricultural Impact Assessment (AIA) report includes proposed tree removal. The property is located within the Department of Planning, Industry and Environment's (DPIE) Biodiversity Values Map (BVM) under the Biodiversity Conservation Act, and any tree removal within the BVM may trigger the Biodiversity Offsets Scheme (BOS) and may require a Biodiversity Development Assessment Report (BDAR). This specific matter is deferred to Council's Bushland & Biodiversity Referral team and subsequently Landscape Referral are unable to continue the assessment.

The proposal is therefore unsupported.
