We are the owners of 31 Neridah Ave Belrose and the following is our submission against the proposed Boarding House which was approved by the Land and Environment Court. We were opposed to the original proposal and the proposal was rejected by two Local Planning Panels. There will only be 31 car spaces onsite which may mean that further vehicles will be parked on surrounding streets. Wyatt Ave is a busy street with local traffic especially during school drop off times. Further traffic may be a danger to local residents and particularly to schoolchildren. Belrose is a beautiful area because it is a low-density housing area which is why we and other families choose to live here. The proposal for high density apartment living in this area is the complete antithesis of the Belrose neighbourhood and its lifestyle.
