Reason for application and outline of proposed work

The tree is question is a gym tree located half way up the stairwell to the front entry of the home. It has large open sap wounds on the tree from the ground upwards. My family lives at the home, have 2 children and I think this is an issue with children being in the front garden with these open sap wounds around the tree at child height. It does not look healthy and I dont want children to be playing around this area.

The tree is located between some spotted gums which are of course, endangered and preserved trees on the property and well loved. I believe the gnarly gum is also impacting and outcompeting the preserved spotted gym for light and space - they are within a meter of the large gum. I think the spotted gums are under nourished and not growing well in the small competitive space on the lawn area. The removal of the gum may assist the endangered spotted gums achieve their potential it could be argued that removal may be appropriate.

I would appreciate a visit to site by Council to review the tree and allow me approval to have the tree removed by a qualified person.

In summary you can see with photos the children's play items are very close to the problem gum tree; you can see the endangered spotted gums on either side and within one metre of the problem gum tree, are stilted in growth; you can see the problem gum is within one metre of the stairwell to the front door.
