UPDATED PLANS FOR SERVICE STATION FUEL STORAGE TANKS - 940 PITTWATER ROAD, DEE WHY

Dear Sir/Madam,

Reference is made to Council's correspondence dated 21 May 2020, regarding the abovementioned Application which was referred to Transport for NSW (TfNSW) for comment in accordance with Schedule 3 of the *State Environmental Planning Policy (Infrastructure)* 2007.

TfNSW has reviewed the submitted documentation and based on the information provided does not provide support for the Development Application in its current form on safety grounds.

TfNSW has the concern that tanker exiting through the driveway closest to the traffic signals at the intersection of Pittwater Road and Hawkesbury Avenue will have negative impact on road safety and traffic efficiency. The tanker should be able to turn fully and face the direction of travel prior to stopping at the signals. This is to ensure the pedestrian safety.

The information requested in TfNSW response, dated 31 May 2020, has not been provided by the applicant and should be submitted to TfNSW for review.
