**Development Application No. DA2023/0127**

**Description:** Alterations and additions to an educational establishment (Narrabeen North Public School) including the removal and replacement of trees, landscaping works, and the installation of a substation and fire hydrant booster

Reference is made to the proposed development at the above area and Aboriginal heritage.

The Aboriginal Heritage Office agrees with the recommendations outlined in the Heritage Advice letter for the Designated Development works proposed with Narrabeen North Primary School,

Given the above, the Aboriginal Heritage Office considers that there are no Aboriginal heritage issues for the proposed development.

Under the National Parks and Wildlife Act 1974 (NPW Act) all Aboriginal objects are protected. Should any Aboriginal Cultural Heritage items be uncovered during earthworks, works should cease in the area and the Aboriginal Heritage Office assess the finds. Under Section 89a of the NPW Act should the objects be found to be Aboriginal, Heritage NSW and the Metropolitan Local Aboriginal Land Council (MLALC) should be contacted.
