#### HERITAGE COMMENTS

#### Discussion of reason for referral

The proposal has been referred to Heritage as the subject site is located opposite a heritage item: **I2270166 - Palm Beach Kindergarten -** 1053 Barrenjoey Road, Palm Beach.

### Details of heritage items affected

Physical Description

One storey timber and concrete structure with brick cladding and slated sloping roof.

#### Statement of Significance

Palm Beach Kindergarten was built in 1958 to a design by Sydney architect Peter Muller, and has aesthetic and historic significance as an excellent example of Late Twentieth-Century Organic architecture. The building is an early example of Muller's work and shows the effect of the community on the provision of community facilities. Palm Beach Kindergarten retains a high level of intactness. It is also technically interesting for its attempt to adapt scale to the heights of its inhabitants, in this case children up to 5 years old.

The proposal seeks consent for alterations and additions to an existing dwelling. The proposed works include the partial demolition of the existing dwelling related primarily to the covered pedestrian way and the primary entrance of the dwelling. Further works include an internal reconfiguration of the ground floor layout and a first floor addition containing a bedroom, bathroom and terrace. The proposal maintains the existing external aesthetic of the dwelling, including the existing appearance of the primary facade. The subject property is located opposite Palm Beach Kindergarten, which is a locally listed heritage item. As the proposal maintains the existing facade of the dwelling, and the proposed works sit within the existing footprint, the proposal is considered acceptable from a heritage perspective, and is not considered to impact upon the significance of the heritage item.

Heritage raises no objections and requires no conditions.
