Purpose of the Waste Management Plan

All applicants are required to complete the 'Applicant and Project Details' part of the WMP and include it with the relevant Sections that apply to their proposed development.

The WMP is divided into Sections and applicants are only required to complete the relevant Sections in accordance with the Guidelines. The table below identifies which Sections are relevant to which development types.
