RE: Pittwater RSL Markets Modification Application

I oppose the modification application.

The market operators clearly cannot adhere to what is required with the COVID 19 crisis and this sets a basic precedent the operators cannot be trusted.

Attached is a set of photos taken from 9.30am Sunday 24 May 2020 at the Pittwater RSL markets at Mona Vale.

These photos were taken for evidence of the market operator's failure to comply with the COVID 19 social distancing requirements and enforce those requirements.

The stalls are not spread out as required, forcing patrons to mingle closely together.

The photos also show the operators delivering 'the' hand sanitizer stand at 10.07am, well after the markets start time at 8.30am.

This and the closeness of the stalls shows contempt these operators have for the rest of us in the community affected by us having to comply with social distancing and the lockdown.

Northern Beaches Council staff appears to be disinterested in COVID 19 and social distancing matters as previous complaints regarding these Pittwater RSL private property markets resulted in no action being taken.

Instead of council considering granting a modification to the original development approval to benefit the market operators Council should be withdrawing the original approval and shutting theses markets down, as the market operators clearly have no regard for responsibility and this has been shown with the recent and ongoing COVID 19 crisis with the markets being a public health risk as evidenced in the photos in spreading COVID 19.

The last few photos also show the lack of available onsite parking as approved with the Development Application and the congestion created with overflow parking onto surrounding residential streets being the result exactly as per what local residents said would happen with objections to NBC prior to the original consent being granted.

NBC didn't listen then to the 'Locals' knowledge of what would happen, it's time the NBC now listens to the 'Locals'.

The Latin maxim Commodum Ex Injuria Sua Nemo Habere Debet is particularly relevant, namely that a wrongdoer should not be enabled by law to take any advantage from his actions. Council must refuse the modification application and shut these markets down altogether !!!!!!!!!
