While I am not directly located near the Frenchs Forest Bushland Cemetery, it has come to my attention for a proposed Chapel / Mortuary to be built where the Caretakers / Managers Cottage has stood since the Cemetery opened for burials.

Why demolish a building which is part of the Cemetery's history? Surely the building could be better utilized as an Information point, e.g. visitors looking for deceased persons burial sites. Local community service clubs could use as a meeting venue.

The proposed entrance to the Chapel is situated on a blind curve in Hakea Avenue and would be dangerous to traffic arriving and leaving the Cemetery precinct. Residents in Hakea Avenue could be impacted by visitors parking and obstructing driveways opposite.

The area currently under construction at North Lawn, would be better suited for a Chapel / Condolence Rooms / toilet facilities.
