Reasons for referral

This application seeks consent for the following:

- Construction / development works within 5 metres of a tree or
- New residential works with three or more dwellings. (RFB's, townhouses, seniors living, guesthouses, etc). or
- Mixed use developments containing three or more residential dwellings.
- New Dwellings or

Officer comments

The proposal, in terms of landscape outcome is acceptable, subject to conditions.

Council's Landscape section has assessed the proposal against the following Pittwater 21 DCP Controls:

B4.22 Preservation of Trees and Bushland Vegetation

C1.1 Landscaping

D16.5 Landscaped Area for Newly Created Individual Allotments

D16.12 Fences

A Landscape Plan is provided with the development application, and this satisfies DA Lodgement Requirements.

The design generally meets the DCP controls with the exception of the proposed property boundary fencing. No fencing is permitted forward of the building line under clause D16.12 Fences, and all plans shall be amended to comply with D16.12.

No Arboricultural Impact Assessment report is required as the does not contain any trees of significance.

Existing street trees within the road reserve fronting development sites must be protected during all stages of works.

CONDITIONS TO BE SATISFIED PRIOR TO THE ISSUE OF THE CONSTRUCTION CERTIFICATE

Amended Landscape Plan

The Landscape Plan shall be amended to remove the proposed fencing forward of the front building line to comply with D16.12 Fences. The DCP clause states:

i) fencing is not permitted forward of the front building line. Boundaries between public and private land shall be delineated by vegetation such as low hedges, garden beds or the like. The Landscape Plan, and all other plans shall be amended to comply with D16.12.

Reason: to ensure that the landscape treatments are installed to provide landscape amenity and ensure appropriate landscape treatment to soften the built form.

CONDITIONS TO BE COMPLIED WITH DURING DEMOLITION AND BUILDING WORK

Protection of existing street trees

- a) all existing street trees in the vicinity of the works shall be retained during all construction stages,
- b) all existing tree guards shall be maintained in place,
- c) any street tree damaged or removed shall be replaced in accordance with guidelines provided by Council.

Reason: to retain and protect tree planting on development sites.

CONDITIONS WHICH MUST BE COMPLIED WITH PRIOR TO THE ISSUE OF THE OCCUPATION CERTIFICATE

Landscape works

Landscaping is to be completed in accordance with the Amended Landscape Plan, inclusive of the following requirements:

- i) all tree planting shall be installed at a minimum 75 litre container size,
- ii) canopy trees shall each have a minimum area of 3 metres x 3 metres contained wholly within the site, and are to be located a minimum of 5 metres from existing and proposed built structures,
- iii) fencing is not permitted forward of the front building line. Boundaries between public and private land shall be delineated by vegetation such as low hedges, garden beds or the like.

Prior to the issue of an Occupation Certificate, a landscape report prepared by a landscape architect or landscape designer shall be submitted to the Certifying Authority, certifying that the landscape works have been completed in accordance with the approved landscape plan and the conditions of consent.

Reason: to ensure that the landscape treatments are installed to provide landscape amenity and ensure appropriate landscape treatment to soften the built form.

ON-GOING CONDITIONS THAT MUST BE COMPLIED WITH AT ALL TIMES

Landscape maintenance

Any existing landscaping required to be retained together with any additional landscaping required by this Consent is to be maintained for the life of the development.

All landscape components are to be maintained for the life of the development. A 12 month landscape

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establishment program is to be undertaken for all planting. If any landscape materials/components or planting under this consent fails, they are to be replaced with similar materials/components and species.

Reason: To maintain local environmental amenity and ensure landscaping continues to soften the built form

Environmental and priority weed control

All weeds are to be removed and controlled in accordance with the NSW Biosecurity Act 2015.

Reason: preservation of environmental amenity.

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
