I am a resident of over 15 years and owner of a property immediately opposite St Augustines school. Over the years it has become clearer and clearer that St Augustine's approach to the local community in which they sit is tokenistic at best and is causing significant friction in the local community. They may once have been welcome but this is no longer the case.

Please accept this email as notification that I am adding my name to the list of signatories to the Petition against this DA. I was away while these were being collected but wholeheartedly agree with them.

Furthermore, I add my support to Mr and Mrs Ali's comments and Mr John Truszewski's detailed submissions. As detailed there a clear picture emerges of St Augustine's school appearing to say one thing but do another, disregard guidelines and agreed limits on student numbers, and then use this as a rationale for further development. Surely this is the wrong way round? Why has the council not acted?
