HERITAGE COMMENTS Discussion of reason for referral

This application has been referred as the subject property is affected by a heritage item, being *Item I1 Harbour foreshores*, listed in Schedule 5 of Manly Local Environmental Plan 2013. The listing extends for the full length of the harbour side boundary of this property following the MHWM. According to the survey submitted with the application, most of this foreshore boundary consists of man-made structures, such as a swimming pool, jetty and stone sea wall.

Consideration of Application

This application proposes the extension of an existing ground floor balcony on the north-western facade of this strata building. It involves a 1 metre extension to the north-west and north-east portions of the balcony with a new wrought iron ballustrade to match the existing. The building is not heritage listed, but appears from photos to have Inter-War Spanish Mission features. Extension of the balcony, using the same curved shape and similar wrought iron ballustrade will not detract from the Spanish Mission characteristics.

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In relation to the heritage item affecting this site, as the proposed works are minor and only affecting the existing building on the site, there will be no impact upon the heritage significance of the *Harbour Foreshores* heritage item.

Therefore, no objections are raised on heritage grounds and no conditions required.
